Trade Offs to Consider

-  Limited capacity for large dishes
-  Manual water refilling required
-  No built-in filter system
-  Plastic materials may wear over time
-  No auto-detection of load size
-  Requires manual setup for each use

- Smaller than standard countertop models
- Less powerful than full-sized units
- No built-in filter or auto-refill
